

Carbon Pool Europe - CO₂ trading platform



Since the beginning of the year 2005 companies are required to measure and record their CO₂ emissions. The comparison with emissions obtained from the base period and estimated emissions in the future shows the company's position - long or short.

The participation in emission trading and therewith buying and selling of emission allowances is dominated by the emissions and strategies of the participating companies. In order to minimize risks and taking advantage of the opportunities the market for emissions allowances offers a solid strategy is essential. It will not be sufficient to decide whether to buy or sell a certain amount of EU Allowances (EUA) at the end of each period. Various fundamental factors influence CO₂ emissions sending the price for emissions certificates up or down. Companies not actively taking part in the EU Emission Trading Scheme (EU ETS) might suffer considerable disadvantages.

The Carbon Pool Europe provides the access to the carbon market that companies need to actively take part in the EU ETS. The Carbon Pool is an international spot trading platform for EUAs valid under the EU ETS.



How the Carbon Pool Europe works

After registering as a pool member sell and buy orders can be placed into the online order book. Order data contain type, volume, price and duration of validity.

As soon as the market price approaches the order price the Carbon Pool team informs sellers and buyers and asks them to transfer their securities to the Pool accounts (trust accounts available).

As soon as the securities have been transferred the orders can be closed. The Carbon Pool team informs buyers and sellers about the successful transaction and initiates the EURO, EUA or CER transfer.

Orders that can not be closed inside of the Pool are placed on the French CO₂ exchange BlueNext.

BlueNext transactions as well as order bundling are an essential part of our trading services making the Carbon Pool the most powerful compliance tool to date.

As the Carbon Pool finances itself through the bid/offer spread the whole service is completely free of charge!

Key features of the Carbon Pool Europe:

- Counterparty anonymity
- Bundling of sell and buy orders
- Order placement via Internet, fax and/or telephone
- Trading primarily inside of the Carbon Pool Europe
- BlueNext as second trading stage
- Transactions may be handled via a trust account
- Web based trading interface
- No fees (except trust account)

How to register for free EUA/CER spot-trading:

When registering as a member of the Carbon Pool Europe spot trading platform we will ask you to provide the following information (via fax-message to +43 2236 8002 7099):

- A copy of the document that confirms the establishment of your company
- An identity document with a recent photograph (e.g. passport)
- Filled in form „Designation of authorized person“

The timeline for selling EUA/CER is usually like this:

- Transfer of EUA/CER into Carbon Pool trading account at: D
- Confirmation of EUA Sell Order at: D
- Order closed: D
- We ask you to send a fax message containing an invoice for the EUA/CER sale at: D
- Initiation of cash transfer to your bank account at: D
- Cash arrives at your bank account at: D+2 (EUR account) or D+4 (non EUR account)

The timeline for buying EUA/CER is usually like this:

- Arrival of cash at Carbon Pool trading account at: D
- Cash is booked into the Carbon Pool trading account at: D
- Confirmation of EUA/CER Buy Order at: D
- Order closed: D
- Initiation of EUA/CER transfer to your emissions registry account at: D
- EUA/CER arrive at your emissions registry account at: D
